News: Spot billed pelicans dying en masse in Andhra Pradesh

- A nematode infestation has led to mass mortality of spot billed pelicans (Pelicanus philippensis) at Telineelapuram Important Bird Area (IBA) in Naupada swamp of Srikakulam district in Andhra Pradesh.
- Over 150 spot billed pelicans have succumbed to the infestation since December, according to Forest officials, with 21 birds dying in the past 72 hours alone.

Spot Billed Pelican

- > The spot-billed or grey pelican is a member of the pelican family.
- > It breeds in southern Asia from southern Iran across India east to Indonesia.
- > It is a bird of large inland and coastal waters, especially large lake.
- At a distance they are difficult to differentiate from other pelicans in the region although it is smaller but at close range the spots on the upper mandible, the lack of bright colours and the greyer plumage are distinctive.
- \succ In some areas these birds nest in large colonies close to human habitations.
- > The IUCN Status of Spot Billed Pelican is Near Threatened (NT).
