News: Chinkara

➤ In a first of its kind judgment, a Sessions Court in Hanumangarh district of Rajasthan has ordered the payment of half of the fine amount, imposed on a convict in a chinkara killing case, to the informer as a prize for helping in the detection of crime against wildlife.

Chinkara

- ➤ Chinkara, or commonly named Indian gazelle is native to Iran, Afghanistan, Pakistan and India. Around 60% of the global population of Indian gazelles is presently found in western Rajasthan.
- ➤ Chinkara live in arid plains and hills, deserts, dry scrub and light forests. They can go without water for long periods and can get sufficient fluids from plants and dew.
- ➤ It has a reddish-buff summer coat with smooth, glossy fur. In winter, the white belly and throat fur is in greater contrast.
- ➤ Horns are found on both males and females, although they are relatively shorter in females.
- ➤ IUCN Red List Status: Least Concern.

Recently, Karnataka has established the second Chinkara Wildlife Sanctuary in
the state in Bukkapatna (Tumakuru district). The first one was established in
2016 in the Yadahalli village in the Bagalkot district.
