News: India climbs seven points to 80 on Passport Index; Singapore at top position

Henley Passport Index 2023

- ➤ The Henley Passport Index is the original ranking of all the world's passports according to the number of destinations their holders can access without a prior visa.
- The ranking is based on exclusive data from the International Air Transport

 Association (IATA), which maintains the world's largest and most accurate database of travel information.
- ➤ It was launched in 2006 and includes 199 different passports.

Global Rankings

- ➤ Singapore ranked the first position (which was earlier held by Japan) with free access to 193 countries followed by Germany, Italy and Spain occupied the 2nd position.
- The citizens of Singapore are able to visit 192 travel destinations out of 227 around the world visa free.

- ➤ Japan is sharing the third position along with Austria, Finland, France, Luxembourg, South Korea and Sweden.
- ➤ At the bottom of the Index were four countries for scoring zero for not permitting visa free access for any passport namely, Afghanistan, North Korea, Papua New Guinea, and Turkmenistan.
- ➤ India rose to the 80th position from earlier 87th rank, with its passport holders allowed to travel visa-free to 60 countries.
- ➤ Henley & Partners also conducted an exclusive new research resulting in the Henley Openness Index which measures how many nations a country allows visa free access to. Here, India was ranked 94 out of a total of 97 ranks for allowing only four countries visa free access.
