## **News:** Clouded Leopard

Two scientists from the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) have found that the clouded leopard in western Assam's Manas National Park and Tiger Reserve seems to play a mysterious game of hide and seek in the tropical canopy forests.

## **Clouded Leopard**

- ➤ Clouded Leopard is named after cloud shaped pattern on its skin.
- ➤ It is listed as Vulnerable on the IUCN Red List.
- ➤ It is the State animal of Meghalaya.
- ➤ It has been added to India's Recovery Programme for Critically Endangered

  Species to aid more research and strengthen conservation efforts.
- ➤ Clouded Leopard prefers grassland, shrubs, subtropical and dense tropical forest up to a height of 7,000 feet occurring from the Himalayan foothills through mainland Southeast Asia into China.
- ➤ In India, it occurs in Sikkim, northern West Bengal, Meghalaya subtropical forests, Tripura, Mizoram, Manipur, Assam, Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh.
