## **News:** Non-Aligned Movement

➤ Recently, Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni, who hosted the 19<sup>th</sup> Summit of the Non-Aligned Movement in Kampala, expressed his regret over the expulsion of Indians by Idi Amin in the 1970s.

## **Non-Alignment Movement (NAM)**

- ➤ Non Alignment Movement (NAM) was formed during the Cold Was as an organisation of States that did not seek to formally align themselves with either the US or the Soviet Union, but sought to remain independent or neutral.
- The basic concept for the group originated in 1955 during discussions that took place at the Asia-Africa Bandung Conference in Indonesia.
- ➤ The first NAM Summit Conference was held in Belgrade, Yugoslavia in September 1961.
- ➤ It has 120 members as of April 2018 comprising 53 from Africa, 39 from Asia, 26 from Latin America and Caribbean and 2 from Europe (Azerbaijan and Belarus).
- Azerbaijan holds the NAM presidency for 3 years until the 19<sup>th</sup> summit in 2022.

As a condition for membership, the states of the Non-Aligned Movemer
cannot be part of a multilateral military alliance such as NATO. It promote
independence of non-aligned countries from great power or block influence
and rivalries.
