News: World Press Freedom

On the occasion of the World Press Freedom Day Conference on 3rd May 2024, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) released a new report indicating a rise in violence against environmental journalists worldwide.

World Press Freedom Index

- World Press Freedom Index was published by Reporters without Borders. Latest Rank of India was 161st out of 180 countries with a score of 36.62. Previous year the rank acquired by India was 150.
- > Top performing countries are Norway, Ireland and Denmark.
- ➢ Worst performing countries are Vietnam, China and North Korea.

India's Neighbours

- Sri Lanka made significant improvement on the index, ranking 135th this year as against 146th in 2022.
- > Pakistan is ranked at 150th position.

The situation has gone from 'problematic' to 'very bad' in three other countries: Tajikistan (down 1 at 153rd), India (down 11 at 161st) and Turkey (down 16 at 165th).
