- ➤ Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft (ASW SWC), Abhay is the 7th of the Anti-Submarine Warfare / Arnala class succeeding the ageing Abhay class corvettes.
- ➤ A total of 16 vessels are being built for the Indian Navy, jointly by Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) and Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE) under the Make in India initiative.
- ➤ The Indian Navy plans to have all 16 vessels in active service by 2026.
- ➤ The ships are on 2 classes namely Mahe class and Arnala class.
- ➤ 5 out of 8 Mahe class ships have been launched and are under sea trials, whereas 7 out of 8 Arnala class ships are under sea trials.
