- ➤ World Soil Day is celebrated 5th December of every year by UN General Assembly to raise awareness worldwide of the importance of soils for food security, agriculture, as well as in mitigation of climate change, poverty alleviation and sustainable development.
- ➤ The first Soil Day was observed on 5th December 2014.
- ➤ 5th December marks the birth anniversary of the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej of Thailand, a key supporter of this initiative.
- ➤ Food and Agricultural Organisation implements the World Soil Day on behalf of UNGA.
- ➤ 2015-2024 is celebrated as International Decade of Soils.
- ➤ 2015 was celebrated as International Year of Soils.
- ➤ Theme for the year 2024 is "Caring for soils: measure, monitor, and manage".
- ➤ Conservation Efforts: In India, Mitti Bachao (Save the Soil) Movement started in Hoshangabad (Narmadapuram), Madhya Pradesh in 1977 against soil degradation caused by the Tawa Dam in Madhya Pradesh.
